

Procedure On Arrival At Bali International Airport

After you disembark from your flight, follow the crowd to the Immigration Area, and look for the World Shoot sign situated just before the highly visible Visa On Arrival (VOA) counters.

Give the smiling World Shoot Staff wearing match t-shirts your passport (and US\$25 cash, if you need a VOA), then feel free to use the nearby washrooms or smoking room while you wait. Once the VOA has been obtained for those who need them (about 5 minutes), you'll be asked to follow our staff to the special WSXV Immigration Desk, where your passport will be processed.

Then, follow our staff to the Baggage Reclaim Area, where your hand-carry will be X-rayed, after which you'll be taken to the nearby baggage carousel to retrieve all your baggage.

World Shoot staff will then take you to see the nice Policeman nearby who will check your guns against the original Import Permit, which has been retained in Bali. You'll also be asked to sign a bilingual "good behaviour with guns" undertaking.

Assuming everything is in order, you'll be given a numbered and colour coded tag for your gun case, which will be delivered to your hotel by Police. The colour coding represents one of the five designated hotels with an approved armoury.

If you're staying at the Ramada Bintang, Hotel Santika, Bali Dynasty or Kuta Paradiso, that's where your guns and ammunition will be delivered. All other guns and ammunition will be taken to the Discovery Kartika Hotel.

You'll then be taken through the regular Customs channels, behind which there are a number of reputable money changers, where you should change US\$50-US\$100 or equivalent into Rupiah.

Finally, you'll be taken outside to where buses will be waiting to whisk you away to your hotel.

Procedure On Arrival At Your Hotel

On arrival at your hotel, go directly to the check-in desk, where you'll be assisted to obtain your room key where the hotel will take an imprint of your credit card to cover incidentals. You should then go to your room, unpack your regular baggage, and freshen up or rest.

Once you've recovered, proceed to the lobby of the Discovery Kartika Hotel, where you'll find another World Shoot desk and a sea of smiling faces who'll direct you to the central Secretariat situated on the first floor (one floor below lobby level).

If your name is on the "CHECK HERE FIRST" big board outside the Secretariat, this means you owe us some money, or we owe you some money. Either way, go to Counter A for settlement. If your name is not on the big board, go straight to Counter B to collect your Competitor's Kit, which includes your Match ID. If you didn't send us your ID photo in advance, you'll firstly need to see the nice man with the camera nearby. Remember to ☺!

Once you have your Match ID, you can use that (and the gun tag issued at the airport), to go to the applicable armoury to retrieve your gun. Of course if you're not staying at one of the five approved hotels, your gun must be stored overnight at the Discovery Kartika Hotel.

WSXV Equipment Pre-Check Schedule

In a concerted effort to minimise inconvenience to competitors, the Equipment Pre-Check in Bali will be conducted for **Production Division competitors only** as follows:

PRE MATCH: At 0630hrs on Wednesday 22 October, at the shooting range.

MAIN MATCH: On Sunday 26 October, according to the schedule below.

1	Kartika Plaza	0700-0830 hours	Armoury on 1/F
2	Bali Dynasty	0900-0930 hours	See sign in lobby
3	Santika Resort	1000-1030 hours	See sign in lobby
4	Ramada Bintang	1100-1200 hours	See sign in lobby
5	Kuta Paradiso	1230-1300 hours	See sign in lobby

Competitors staying at the Kartika with the self storage privilege must bring their guns (and all magazines), concealed in a bag to the official armoury situated one floor below the lobby level. Competitors staying elsewhere but using the official armoury at the Kartika just need to bring their gun claim tag, so that they can retrieve their gun for inspection, and then return it.

Competitors are urged to arrive for inspection early, **not** at the last minute. Sessions will end strictly on time. No exceptions.

The object of this exercise is for the Production Division Inspection Team to visit the five hotels with approved armouries, rather than have dozens of competitors walking along in the street with their guns to a single location.

Competitors taking more than one handgun to Bali will only have their primary gun checked. If it's necessary to use a replacement gun, competitors must firstly seek approval of the Range Master, who will conduct his own inspection of any proposed replacement gun.

Competitors in Production Division are reminded that the Pre-Check is intended to assist you to check if **your handgun and all magazines you intend to use**, are in compliance with the rules. However passing the Pre-Check is not an equipment waiver.

Competitors found not to be in compliance during the match will remain subject to:

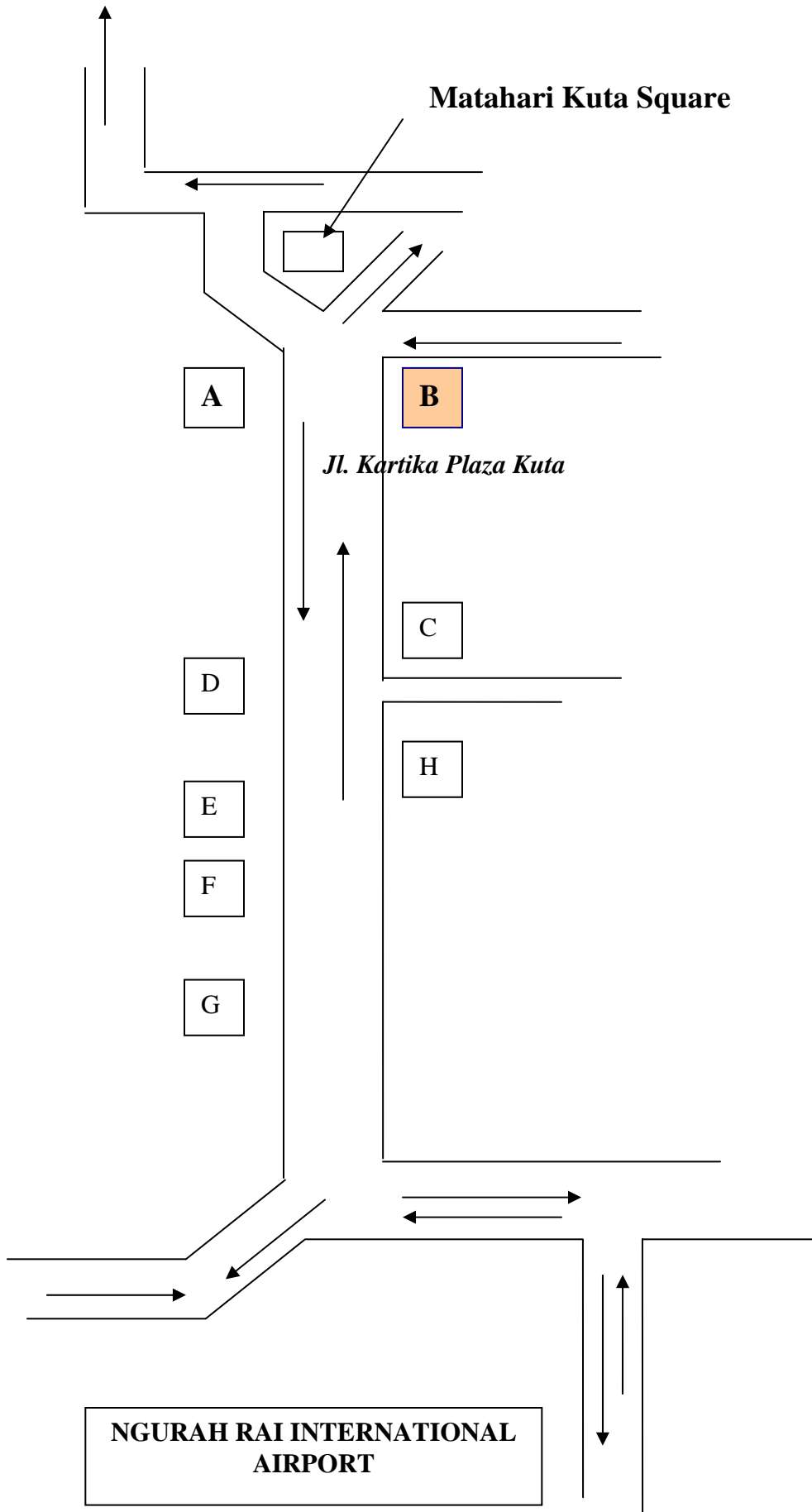
6.2.5.1 However, if a competitor fails to satisfy the equipment or other requirements of a declared Division during a course of fire, the competitor will be placed in Open Division, if available, otherwise the competitor will shoot the match for no score.

Competitors in Open, Standard, Modified and Revolver Standard Divisions will be checked during the match at various Stages, and are also subject to Rule 6.2.5.1.
