

# Smart Packing Guide

for travelling by air with handguns and ammunition

When travelling with handguns and ammunition, pack them in a sturdy, hard-sided and lockable case dedicated exclusively to them.

This way, whether you check-in that case separately, or whether you place it inside a larger piece of luggage, it will be easy to retrieve the case when required to do so for inspection by authorities, and for storage with Customs at airports such as Hong Kong.

Excellent water-proof cases are made by companies such as Pelican Products:



You can pack your ammunition together with your handguns inside the same case provided your ammunition is stored in suitable containers such as those made by MTM Case-Guard:



Airlines are often reluctant to accept ammunition merely stored in their original cardboard boxes, so avoid problems by planning ahead.

Finally, ensure that your magazines and any spare parts you're carrying are also stored inside the dedicated handgun case, and **double-check** that you don't have any loose rounds of ammunition or empty cases in your pockets, in your cuffs or in any cabin baggage!
